

## **Kerry Feldman bio**

Kerry Feldman, Ph.D., is Professor Emeritus of Anthropology at the University of Alaska Anchorage. Five Star/Gale/Cengage Press published his novel, *Alice's Trading Post: A Novel of the West*, Jan. 19, 2022. Cirque Press published March 18, 2022 his noir crime novel, *Kettle Dance: A Big Sky Murder*. Cirque Press published (2019) his 12 often hilarious stories about the Euro-American romantic notions of love and marriage, *Drunk on Love: Twelve Stories to Savor Responsibly*. He is completing a research memoir ("Self-Discovery in Lands Far Away"), a YA Coming-of-Age novel, and a novel about beliefs, self-discovery and love. He hitchhiked through Europe in his early 20s to "see where America came from," discovering in that process a lifelong fascination in people, their histories and how cultural beliefs map out lives. He is married, lives in Alaska, has one daughter and an incredible granddaughter. Feldman was born and raised on the eastern Montana prairie, and completed his doctorate in anthropology at the University of Colorado, Boulder (1973).
